Book of the Iliad 1 1-7 book: Homer invites the goddess of poetry and inspiration (the Musa) to sing the Achilles anger. 8-52: Chryseus, Apollo's priest, arrives at the Greek camp to collect daughter of him, Chryseis, held Agamemnonne prisoner. He is insulted and sent away, and Apollo sends a plague on the Greeks. 53-305: inspired by the goddess, Hera, Achilleus calls an assembly to face the plague, and the Prophet, Kalchas, reveals that Apollo was angry from the refusal of Agamemnone to give back the daughter of his priest. Agamemnone accepts reluctant to give her back, but requires compensation. This causes Achilleus' anger, and, after exchanging threats and angry words, Agaamemnone decides to take the Achilleus "award", the prisoner woman, A e Briseis. The goddess, Athene, prevents Achilleus from killing Agamemnone promising that one day he will be offset three times more prizes. Nestore's efforts to make peace fail. 306-430: Agamemnone's men take Briseis from Achilleus, and Achilleus prays his Divine mother, Thetis, to ask for help. She says she will not fight, and asks her to persuade Zeus to make the battle to feel bad for the Greeks so they'll see that they wouldn't have disabled him. 430-87: Odysseo leads a group of Greeks in Chryse (the place!) To return Chryseis (the daughter!) To Chrysi (the priest!). Meanwhile, Achilleus is an isolate from the other Greeks. 488-611: Thetis, implores Zeus to honor her son, Achilleus, transforming the battle against the Greeks, so they will see that they need him. Afterwards, Zeus's wife, Hera, Bikers with him on the plane of her, and the lame god, Epheistos, tries to make peace among them. Book 2 Zeus starts to take its promise to Thetis to bring honor to Achilleus. First of all, he deceives Agamemnone with a dream that promises victory. Athene convinces Pandaros, a Trojan, to shoot an arrow in Menelaos. Menelaos is wounded, the truce is broken and, like Agamemnone Rally the troops, fighting. Book 5 Exploits of Diomedes on the battlefield dominate this section. After he wound Afrodite, Ares, the God of war, intervenes to help Trojans. The goddess, Hera and Athene, participate in the Greek side. Book 6 Diomedes and Glaukos, an ally of the Trojans, they meet, but not to fight because they discover that they are "friends of guests": their grandparents had visited and have exchanged gifts. Then, Hektor returns to Troy to ask women Of Trojan to make a sacrifice in Athene to win her pity. He visits Helen and reproach her brother of her, Paris, to abandon the battlefield. The wounded Greek warriors return to fighting. A Hera seduces her husband of her, Zeus, to distract him and allow Poseidon to continue to help the Greeks. While the Rally of the Greeks, hektor is wounded. Zeus wakes up and threatens others of others, forcing them to stop helping Greeks. Then, Zeus outlines the future course of the battle and sends Apollo to revive Hektor.â Hektor returns to the battle, pushes the Greeks to their ships and tries to flames the ships. Book 16 Following the advice of Nestor A e a, - A "e s, Patroklos persuade Achilleus to make him wear his armor and conduct the troops, mymidons, in battle. Achilleus warns him to go back once he led the Trojans from ships. The Trojans are Routed, and Patroklos kills one of their great allies, Sarpedon, a deadly son of Zeus.â e Zeus is persuaded by Hera not to intervene to save son of him. Patroklos ignores the Achilleus warning and killed by Hektor with the help of Apollo. Book 17 The two teams fight Patroklos's corpse, after hektor the Achilleus armor strips. Yes, the Iliad is just a huge poem. He also wrote the odyssey, another enormous poem. In Greek, it means Iliou Troy. Therefore, the Iliad is the story of Troia. Well, most people think about the Iliad is the story of the Trojan war. This is the war in which the Achei (Greeks) won using a gigantic wooden horse to deceive the Trojans, from here the name of Trojan horse. The Iliad is not really the story of the Trojan War. It takes place in the tenth year of the Trojan war and ends before the Achei build the Trojan horse and win the war. The Iliad is about Achilles. Achille is a bad ass warrior, which was presumably immortal except for him. Now, if your teacher asks you what the Iliad is about, you should say: "The Iliad is the tragedy of Achille." Which will make you look really intelligent in the classroom. Achillean protagonists (Achilles): The son of Peleus and the goddess of the sea Teti. This guy is the best warrior Achea. He was told that he could go and fight in the Trojan war and die young, or not to fight and live a long life. He goes and fights. Agamemnone: This is the upper boy of the Achaean. He is the leader, but not the best fighter. Him brother of him Menelaos is married to Helen. Menelaos (Menelao): AgamemNonA e s Brother and King of Sparta. He is married to Elena and he honor him is the reason why the Achaean are fighting. Helen: This is the girl that the Trojan war started again. The Aphrodite goddess gave it to Paris because Paris she voted her was the most beautiful goddess, who started this war. She doesn't seem like Paris more so much though. Alexandros (Paris): It is a Prince Troiano, son of Priamo and Ettore's brother. This boy is the cause of the Trojan war. He is a handsome guy who would have preferred to be in bed then fight. Hektor (Hektor): He is the son of Priamo and Hekabe, Andromaca husband, Paris brother, and the best Trojan warrior. Hektor is the good Trojan boy. It really is a bad ass warrior mainly because no divinity will ever to fight and he still kicks his ass. Diomedes: It's another Achaian warrior. He is helped a lot from the Dera Athena. Nestore: It is an elderly Achaian warrior that provides some wise leadership. Patroklos (Patroclus): best friend for Achilles. He comes out and killed and this makes Achilles in contact with fight. Aphrodite: the goddess of love. She supports Trojans because she is the one who gave Helen in Paris. Apollo: It's the God of the Sun. It is the one who starts the whole fight between Agamemnone and Achilles. He supports Trojans. Ares: It's the God of war. He represents the spirit of war and usually helps Trojans. Athene (Athena): the goddess of wisdom. Supports the Achaean because Paris has chosen Aphrodite as the best goddess about her. Efeleistos (ephesto): The Volcano God who is the Locksmith of the Gods. He does the Achilles armor and also helps him save his ass when he fights a river god. She was: Zeus's wife. Hera claims the acai because Paris chose Aphrodite on her as the most beautiful goddess. Poseidon: The God of the sea. He is on the part of the Acai. It's Zeus's brother. Thetis: The Mother of Achilles. She helps Achilles getting Zeus to win the Trojans after fighting with Agamemnone. Zeus: It is the king of the gods. If he wants something, he gets it. No one jokes with him. Aristeia: the point where a warrior is at its maximum intensity and power. Greeks: â, there are a lot of names for the Greeks. The main one are the Achiani. Others are the Argivers and Dannens. Plot The Iliad has 24 books, so instead of making a huge plot summary and then the chapter chapter, we give you the summary for each book. Some books are more important than those others are, and a lot of times teachers do not make their classes read all 24 books. But, we covered every book in case your teacher is an idiot. Here is the basic texture. Achilles comes into question with Agamemnone, King Ahaian, who removes his slave woman, so Achilles stops fighting. Achilles asks Zeus to make the Achaiani lose the war. Then the Trojans begin to beat the Achaians really bad. Then the best friend Achilles, Patroklos goes to fight for him and get her ass killed by Hektor and Achilles is sad. Chrysees pray to Apollo to punish the Achaean to not return to his daughter and so Apollo starts shooting the Achaians with his silver arch (fundamentally this means that the Greeks have begun to get sick). This goes on for nine days and then Achilles has had enough and call a meeting to find out what the hell is happening. This Kalchas guy who is a soothsaker (means that in contact with the gods) says them that Apollo is making them die because Agamemnone would not return the daughter of that priest. Agamemnone is pissed off because he doesn't think he would have to give up the girl. Agamemnon and Achilles begin to discuss. Achilles says to return the girl, and Agaemnone says, if I have regal the back ... I'm taking your woman, Briseis. Achilles gets angry because he fought for ten years for Agamemnone and faint. Agamemnon will not come back and requires Achilles woman. Achille is about to kill Agamemnone when Athena (goddess of wisdom) stops him. So this old Nestor, steps to try to calm things but fails, he can. Free a girl, cruiseide and takes Achilles woman. Achilles bales and will no longer fight. Then, Achille turns off crying for him mom, Thetis, who is a goddess of the sea. He asks her to ask Zeus if he will make the Trojans win the war, while Achilles is not fighting in an agam-in a way you will need to ask him to come back. Thetis goes to Zeus and asks him. He is reluctant, but he agrees to do so because his wife was, he supports the Achaean and he likes to piss her street. Book II Zeus Agamenna screws telling him in a dream to attack the Trojans. Agamemnone tries to test men by him saying them that they should separate home. All the men of him are like, fuck yes, we're out of here. Agamemnone agrees and says that he will give him his back of women and all this gold, horses, and more. He sends some guys talking to Achilleus. Achille is sitting in him's tent to sing a poem. First, Ulysses tries to convince Achilleus to come back. Achilleus doesn't say why he thinks that he honor him was messed with, and no quantities of gifts will help. Then an old Achille family friend, Phoenix, tries to return Achilles in the ring, but Achilles say no. Then Big Aias says Achilles that he should come back to fight him friends who need him. Achilleus says he won e t even if everyone is killed. They realize that he won e t budge and leave. Book XV Zeus wakes up and gets pissed off. He shouts to Hera and tells her in detail on how to win the Trojans until Achilles comes into battle. Then he moves away to fix the plans of him. He gets Hektor all wired and the Trojans start to kick your ass. Zeus is sure that Hektor is not wounded. Booking XVI Patroklos is all upset at the loss of Achei, then goes to Achille to tell him about this. He shouts to Achilleus to not be involved and asks if he can wear Achilles armor to help acai. Achilleus agrees and helps patrol to be suitable. He tells Patroklos not to push to the walls of Troy because he will make unhappy of God. Achille calls the followers of him, mymidons, and prepare them for the battle. Trojans are all scared when they see Patroklos, because they think it's Achilles. Everyone starts running. Patroklos moves the Achaes forward by killing a lot of people. Patroklos goes far and pounded Apollo that strikes him in the back while he is fighting, the armor of him comes off, and Hektor ends. Book XVII All fighting on the body of Patroklos and the armor of Achilles. The Achei wants to give Patroklos an adequate burial and the Trojans want Achilles armor. Hektor takes the armor and the Achaean continue to fight for the body. The son of Nestor, Antilichos, moves away to tell Achilles of what happened. The Trojans begin to win again. Booking XVIII Antilichos tells Achilles. Achille is really sad and shouts. Achilleus see Trojans and shouts. Achille is angry to himself for having left him to happen, and decided to take his anger on Hektor. Her her mother thetis goes out to take a somewhat armor son, but Hera sends Iris to tell Achilles that you need to move now because Hektor is about to drag the body of Patroklos to Troy. Achille comes out unarmed and scares the Trojans because there is all this thunder and lightning and there is a circle of flames around the head of him. Hektor's friend tells him that he should go back to Troy but he doesn't listen. Thetis is at home of Ephaistos, who is making new armor for Achilles. She makes this really fantastic shield that has all these different scenes about it of stars and cities and celebrations. Homer takes a long time to describe it. Book XIX the next day Thetis dA in Achille the new armor of her. Achille calls all the achaian together and compensate with agamemnone. Agamemnone wants to give Achilles all the gifts he promised him. Achilles wants to hurry up and fight and skip the giving gift. He also wants to skip breakfast. Odisseo says they need to eat and that they should exchange gifts to make sure it's all cleaned. So, Achille gets the things of him and the woman of him back. Then the horse of him, yes, the horse of him, tells Achilles that he will die if he fights. Achille knows it and says it's not important. Combat. Book XX Zeus let the gods get involved again because he knows Achilles is on Warpath. Achilles is killing everyone. He runs into Aeneias and kill him too, but Poseidon saves him because Aeneias is destined to live so he can visit Rome (read Aeneid). Apollo hides Ettore in a fog, so Achilles will not see it. Achilles continues to infuriate. Booking XXI Achilles is pushing the Trojans back killing everyone to him. He does not save any mercy. All these Trojans fall into the Xanthos river and Achilles follows to kill them. The god of the river, Xanthos, asks Achilles to stop killing people in the river of him because the water is becoming all bloody. Achilles agrees but then Xanthos turns and asks Apollo to help Trojans. Achille is in this way he attacks the river e â, - | Figure. So he and the river fight. Hera gets Epheistos to burn the plains that boil the river and leaves only Achilles. Then all the gods begin to fight again except for Zeus. So, then, I meet this Agenor of Trojan Agenor at Troy's ports. They start fighting, but Apollo hides the Agenor in a fog and let him run away. Apollo therefore takes the form of Agenor and leads Achilles away from the doors. Then all the Trojans run into the city. Booking XXII Achilles realizes that he was deceived by Apollo and tells the battle. King Priam is watching and is sad. He knows that bad things will happen to Troy and he son of him Hektor. He and Hektor's Momma, Hekabe, tries to convince Hektor not to fight Achilles. Hekabe pulls out her breast as a maternity show to convince him. Hektor disposes it, but he hears him honor of him is on the line and must defend his city. Then Achille arrives after Hektor and Hektor is overwhelmed and runs away. Achilles chasing Hektor around the city walls. Athena Tricks Hektor to stop. Hektor asks Achilles that no matter what happens, they can't reject each other. Achilles does not say in any way and strikes him through his throat. Then he strips Hektor's body of his armor, puts the holes in his ankles, puts the rope through the holes and drags the body around the city of Troy behind a wagon. Bad. The gods do not let the body mess up. Everyone in Troy are sad. Book XXIII Achilles and the boys of him, the Myrmidions, hold a funeral party for Patroklos. Then Patroklos returns from dead as a ghost that asks Achilles to burst him quickly so can go to the land of the dead. Achilles builds an enormous funerary pira (a funeral pyre is a large pile of wood and things that put a corpse and burning) and burns patroklos. Then the next day, Achilles contains funeral games for Patroklos. These games are like boxing, wrestling, race, etc. The last game is the launch of lance and Achilles let Agaemennon wins because it is the leader and are trying to be friends. Book XXIV Achilles fails to overcome Patroklos's death. He can't sleep so he gets up and drags Hektor's body around the funeral pyre. Zeus says to Thetis, AchilleSA e â, - à "e Mom, to go and give him enough is enough and giving the body back. Then, King Priam is driven by the God Hermes to Achilles tent and begs for Hektor's body. Achilles and Priam cry on their loss. Achilles thinks you kill Priam, but let him go and take Hektor's body. Hektor's mother, wife of him, and Helen all death of the plug of Ettore and the Trojans build a great funeral pyre and burn Hektor. Things to make you look intelligent The main figure in this story is Achilles. It seems that the whole story revolves around him, even if it does not appear in most of it. Achille is a bit of an inconsistent character. It is blessed by the gods and considered a true hero, but he falls prey to pettinating and leaves his friends to die when they need him. It's really faithful to anyone or is just faithful to her own? You can discuss both sides. Aias Telemonian, Ajax Maggioro, is an interesting character to analyze. He is a great warrior and never receives any help from God. The gods help all the other heroes in the Iliad when they are fighting, but aias never even. Later in history, AIAS is killed to insult athena. If asked who is the largest warrior, why not aias? He wins the terms of him without help of the gods. An important theme is the will of the gods. The Gods often decide the destiny of men. Zeus decides everything albeit at times, it is not clear if he is deciding the destiny or simply respecting him. He notices the scene in which he uses a ladder to weigh the destiny of the Greeks and Trojans in battle. How much does he decide in reality? The gods often represent the traits of humanity. The honor is another important theme in the Iliad. Hektor Fights for the honor of Troy. The Achians fight for the honor of Menelaus whose wife, Helen, is in Troy. Troy.
